Stage Right Present The Carol Burnett Show April 20 - May 6 at Crighton Theatre

Stage Right of Texas, resident theatre company at the historic Crighton Theatre, will present The Carol Burnett Show April 20 – May 6. Adapted for the stage by Director Sam Martinez, The Carol Burnett Show will be an homage to the variety / sketch comedy television show that starred Carol Burnett, Harvey Korman, Vicki Lawrence, Lyle Waggoner, and Tim Conway. The television show originally ran on CBS from September

11, 1967, to March 29, 1978, for 278 episodes and originated from CBS Television City's Studio 33 (known today as the Bob Barker Studio). The series won 25 prime time Emmy Awards, was ranked #16 on TV Guide's 50 Greatest TV Shows of All Time in 2002 and in 2007 was listed as one of Time magazine's "100 Best TV Shows of All Time." Stage Right will recreate some of the classic comedy sketches including "As the

Stomach Turns," "The Family," and spoofs of old movies as well as movie musical numbers. Please note that Ms. Burnett and the original TV cast members are NOT appearing in the show.
